Hyatt Farms Long Range Precision Rifle Marksmanship Class

To ensure a productive and safe experience during your Long Range Precision Marksmanship class, please review the following required and recommended items:

Optic Requirements

- **Scope:** Minimum **8x magnification**, **exposed turrets**, and **adjustable parallax (side focus knob)**.
 - **Reticle Type:** MOA or MRAD with tree-style reticles preferred. **BDC reticles are acceptable only if you are using the exact ammunition they were designed for.**
 - **Brands:** Any reputable or widely used brand is acceptable.

Ammunition

- **Match-Grade Ammo:** Bring a minimum of **60 rounds**.
 - We carry a variety of calibers and brands in our **Pro Shop**. If you plan to purchase ammo on the day of the class, please call ahead to confirm availability.

Scope Mounting

- **Torque Check Required:**
Ensure your **scope rings and mounts are torqued to the manufacturer's specifications**.

If you are unsure, we strongly recommend contacting us before class to speak with our gunsmith for assistance.

- Bring a **notebook** and **pen or pencil** for the classroom instruction portion.
